1 Corinthians 12:24b-25

God has so arranged the body, giving the greater honor to the inferior member, that there may be no dissension within the body, but the members may have the same care for one another.

In the passage above, Paul is addressing the church at Corinth. Prior to this, Paul was drawing the similarities to the body as a whole and showing how the individual parts make the whole body work together. In this passage, he is asking them to care for one another as equals and not as one who is superior over another. We do this when we lift up prayers of joys and concerns in our church services or Sunday school classes or reunion groups. By doing so, we unite ourselves with each other as brothers and sisters in Christ. Our concern is for the common good of all whether they are doctors, lawyers, social workers or carpenters. 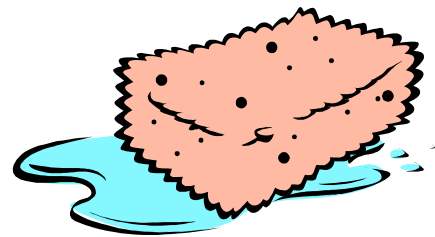
